

- attend professional development workshops.



Mining Hiring and Employment Forecast 2017-2027





Local Labour Market Forecast Update ↑

The FNETB is updating the Local Labour Market Forecast report with Statistics Canada 2016 Census Data. The forecast looks at anticipated retirements based on the number of people employed by occupations, by 5-year age cohort, for each of the Community Futures Development Corporations that fall within the FNETB's service area. The updated forecast will be released at the AGM on October 11th.
