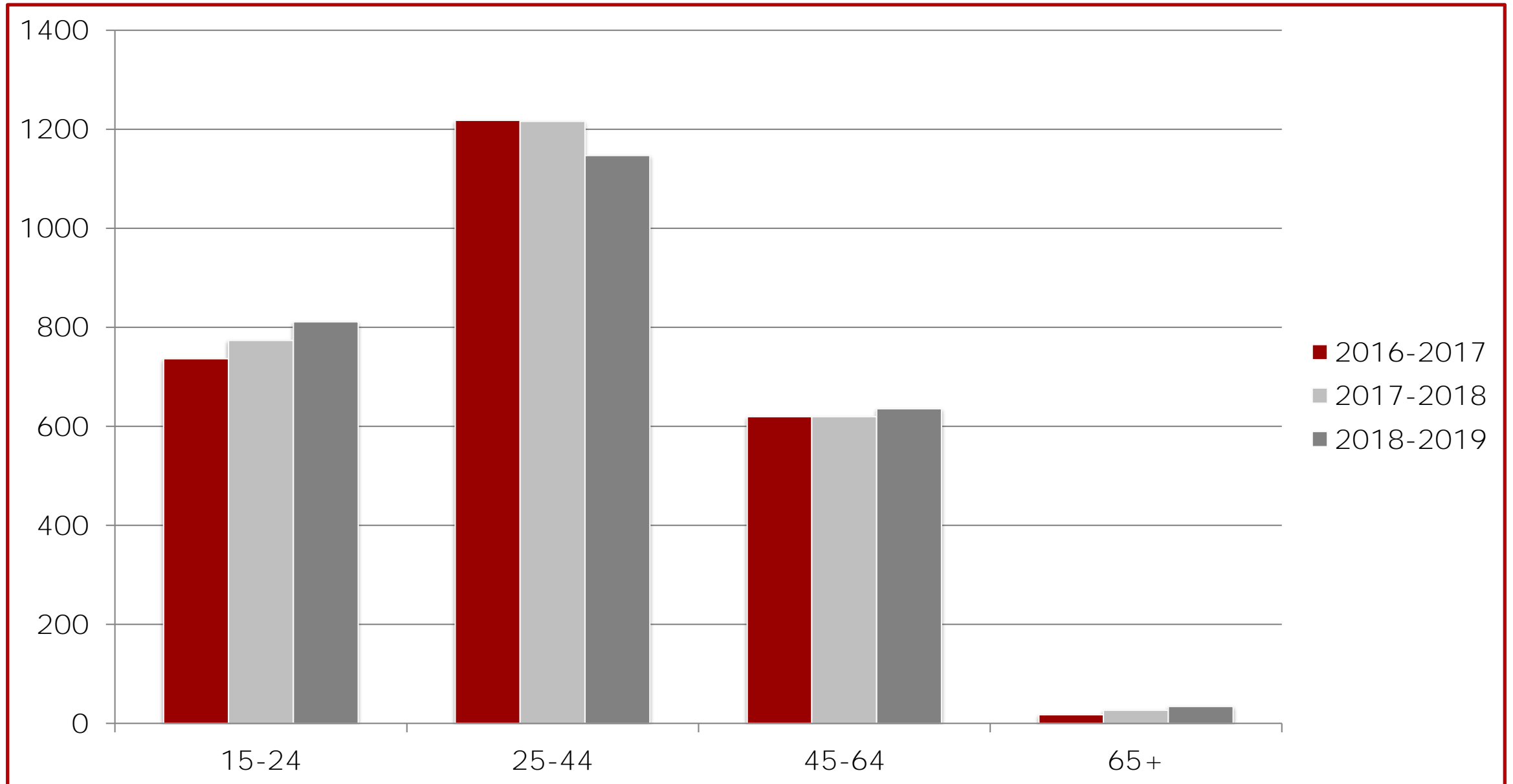

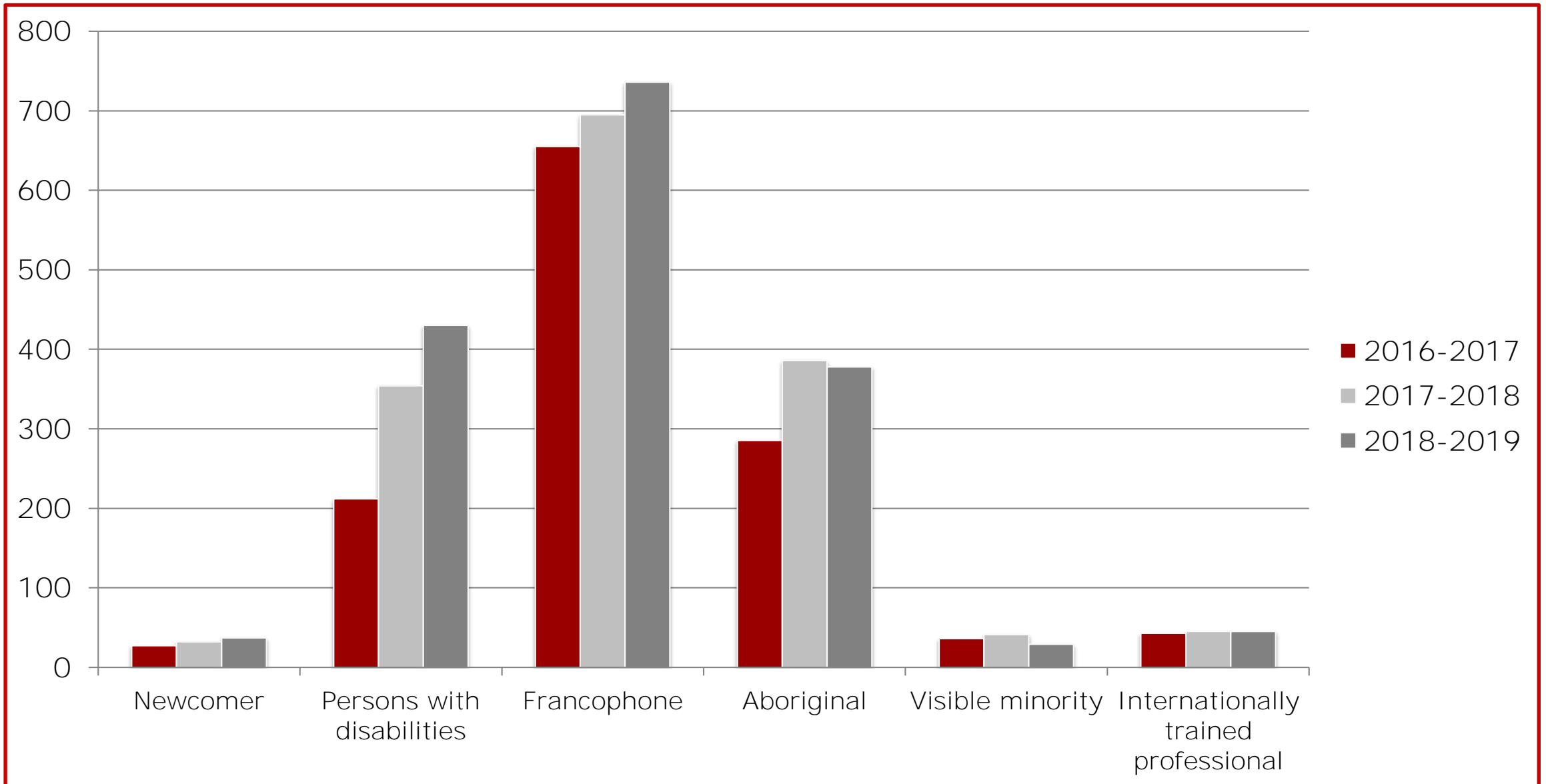
ES CLIENTS BY GENDER



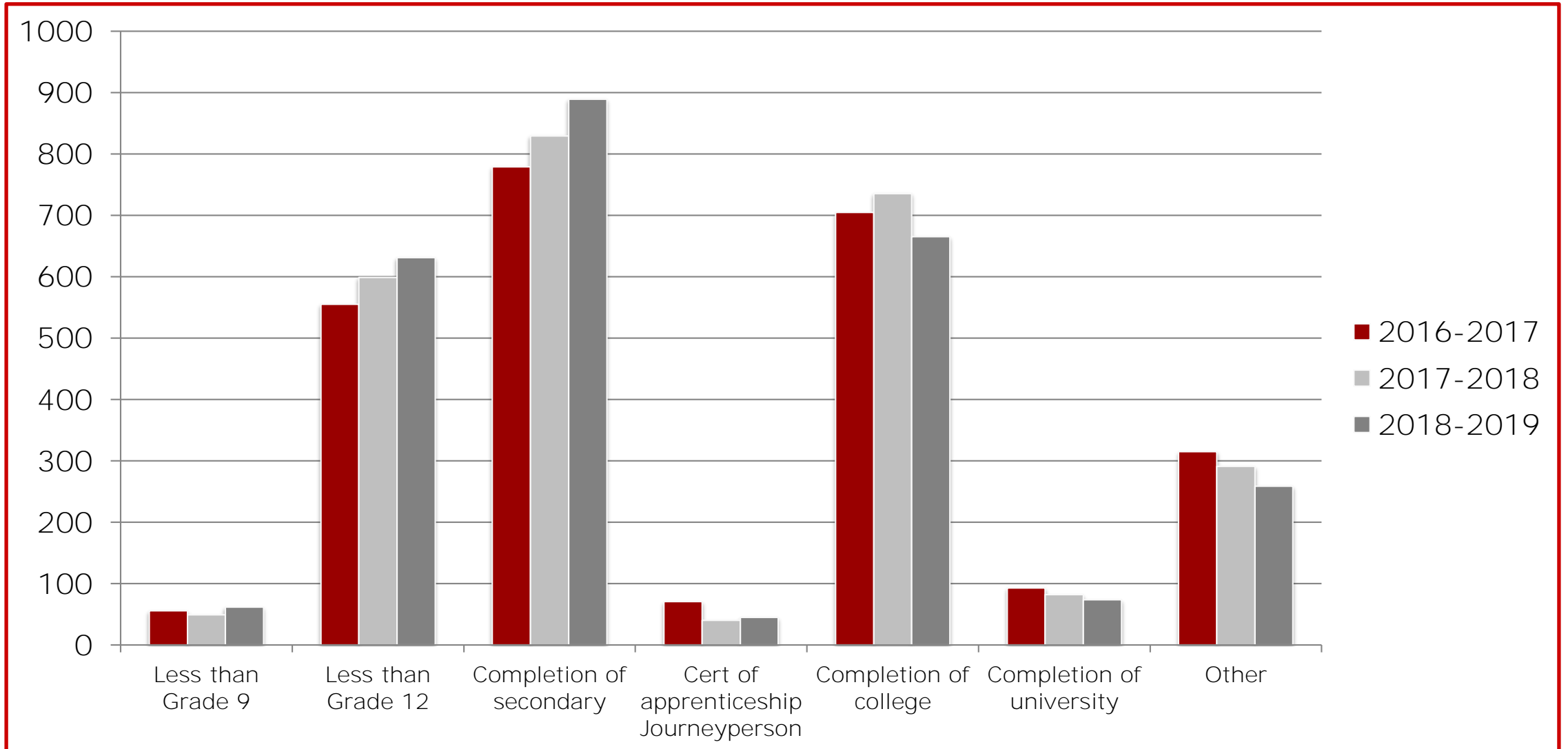

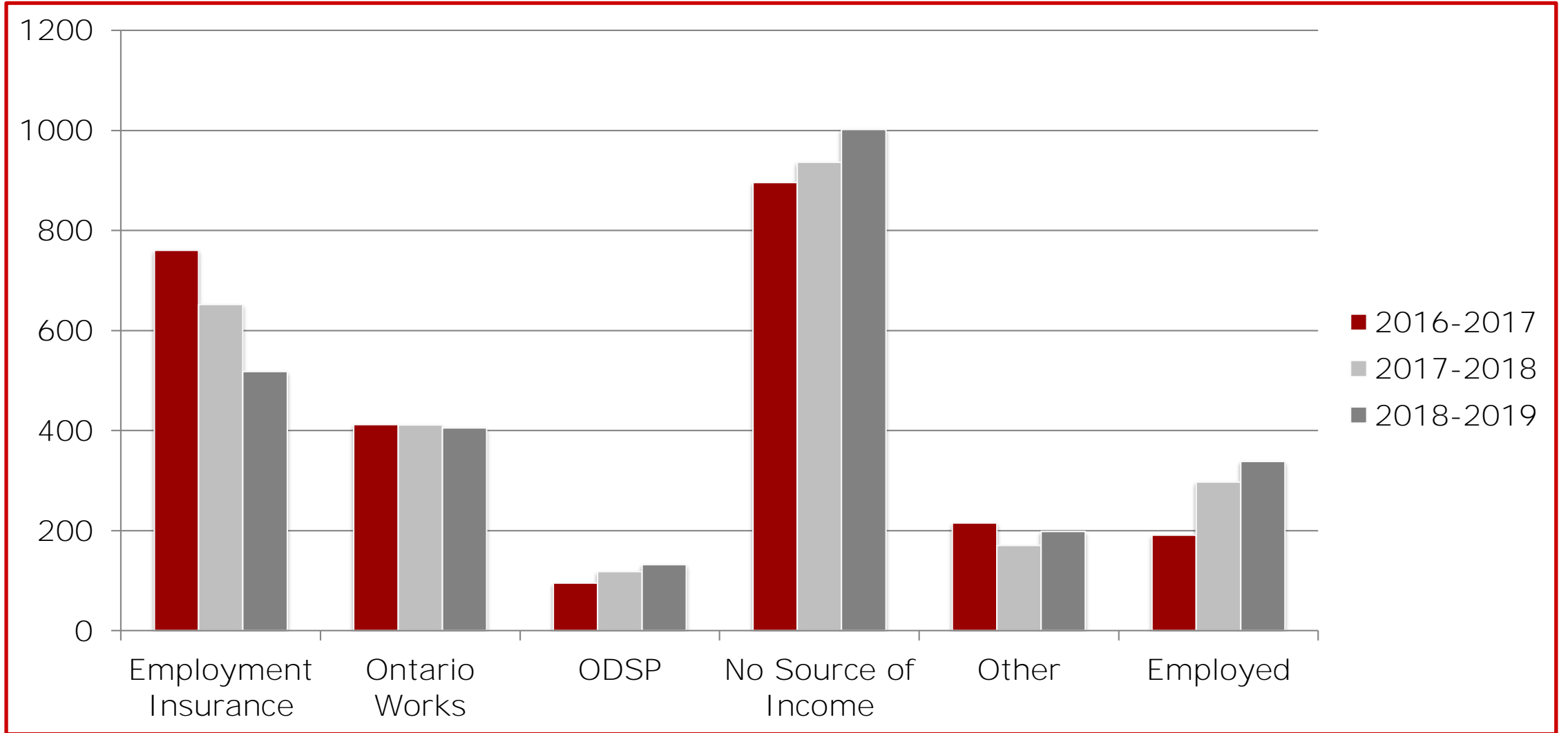

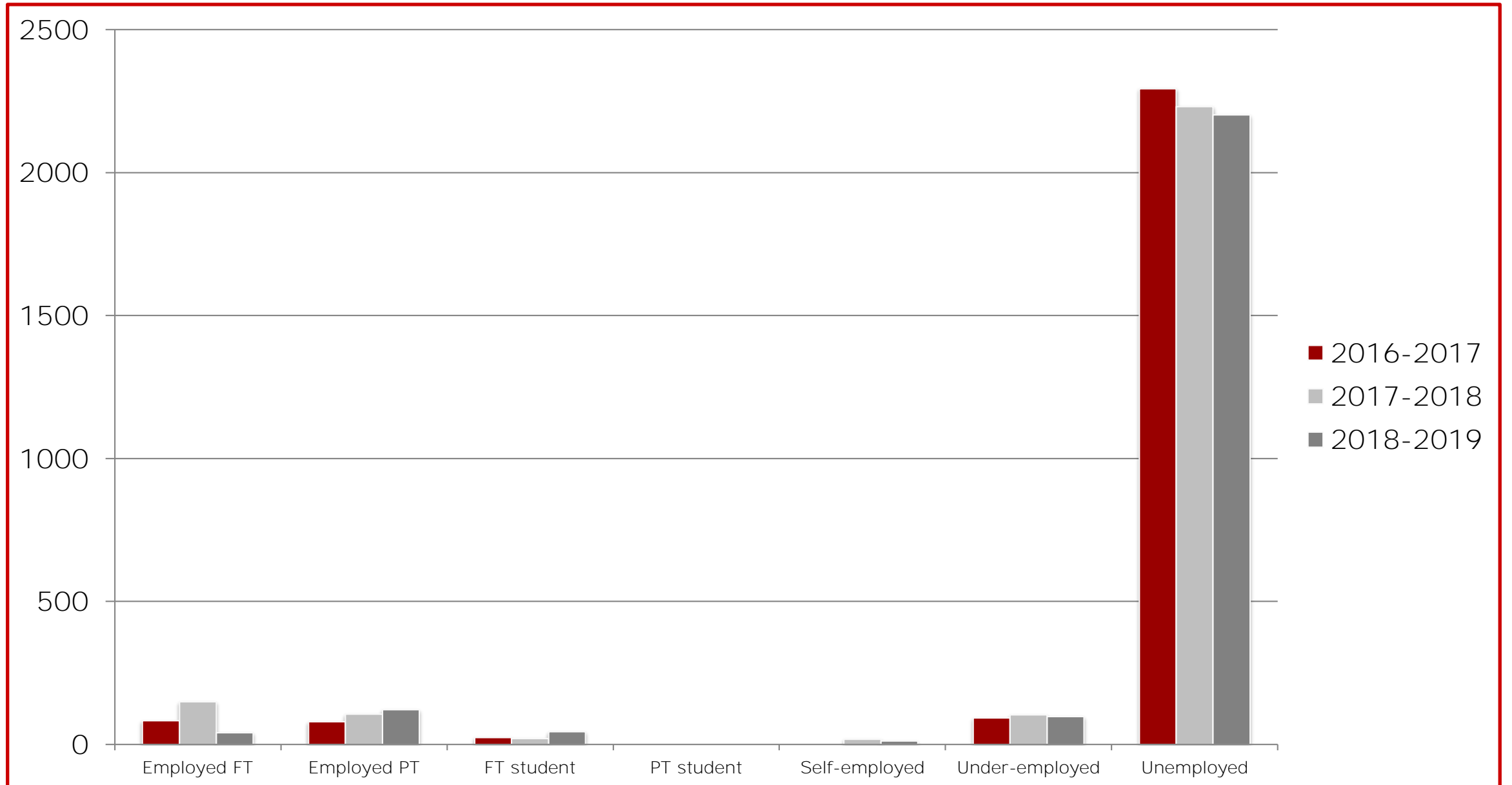

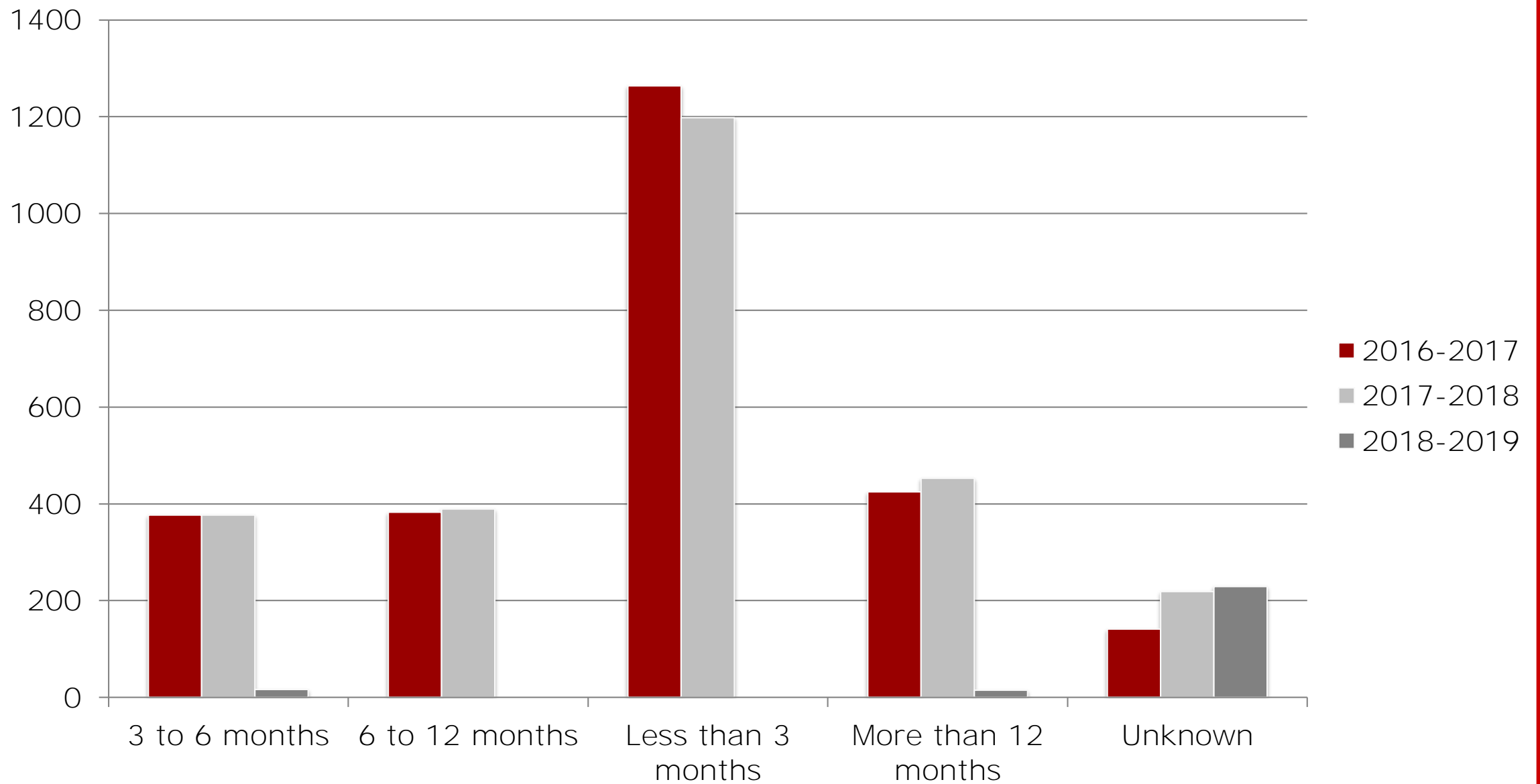

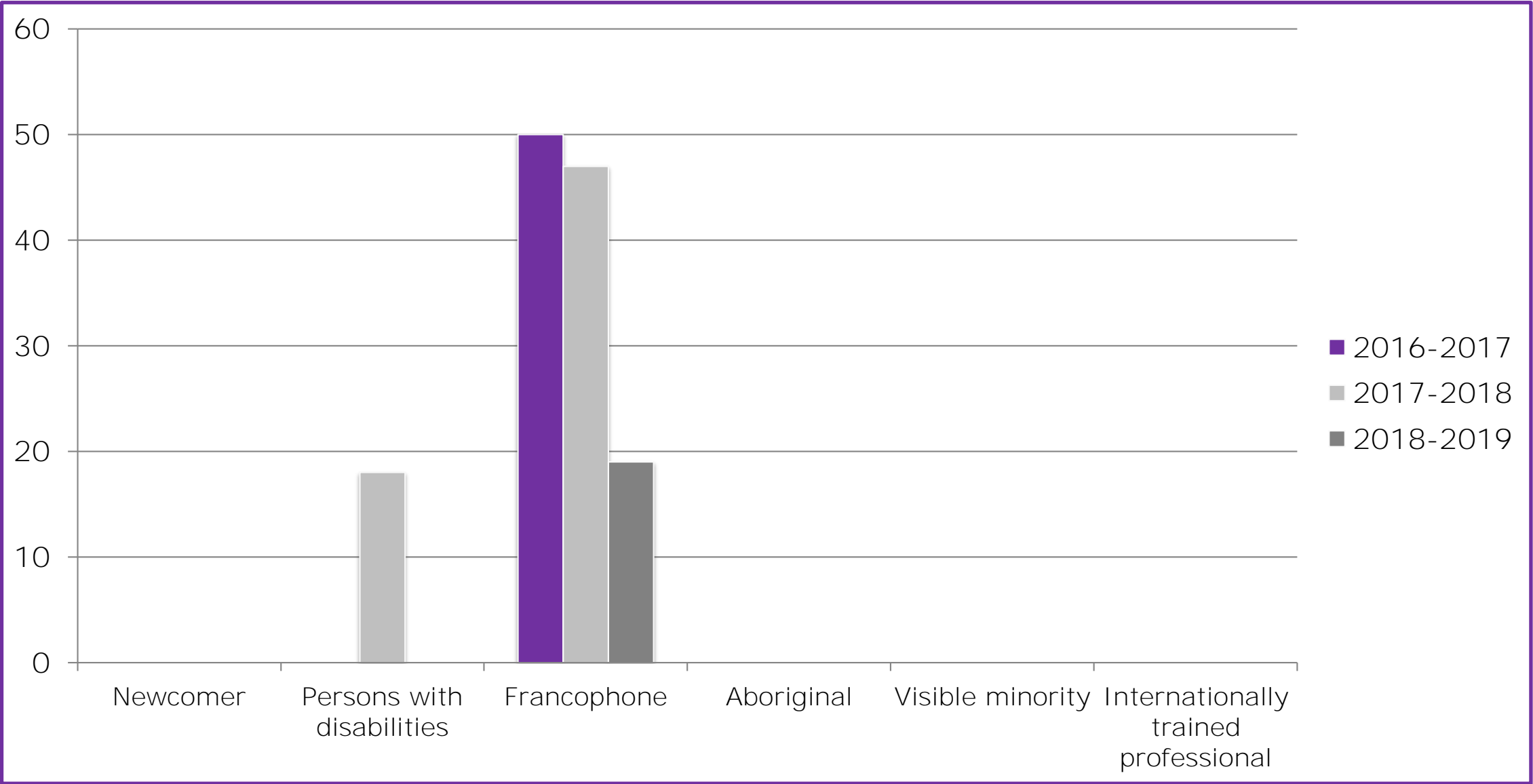
SECOND CAREER CLIENTS BY GENDER



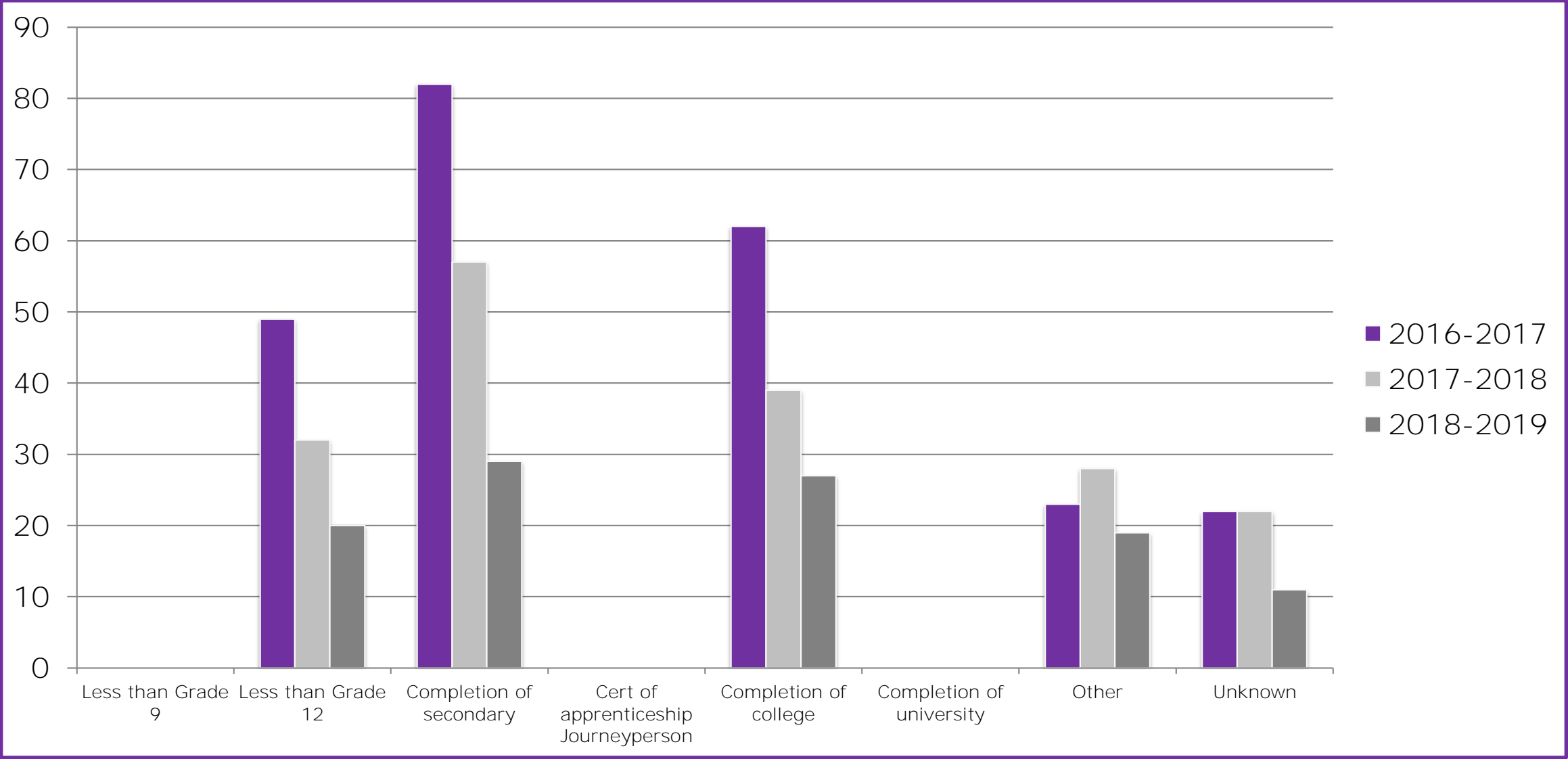
SECOND CAREER CLIENTS BY AGE GROUP



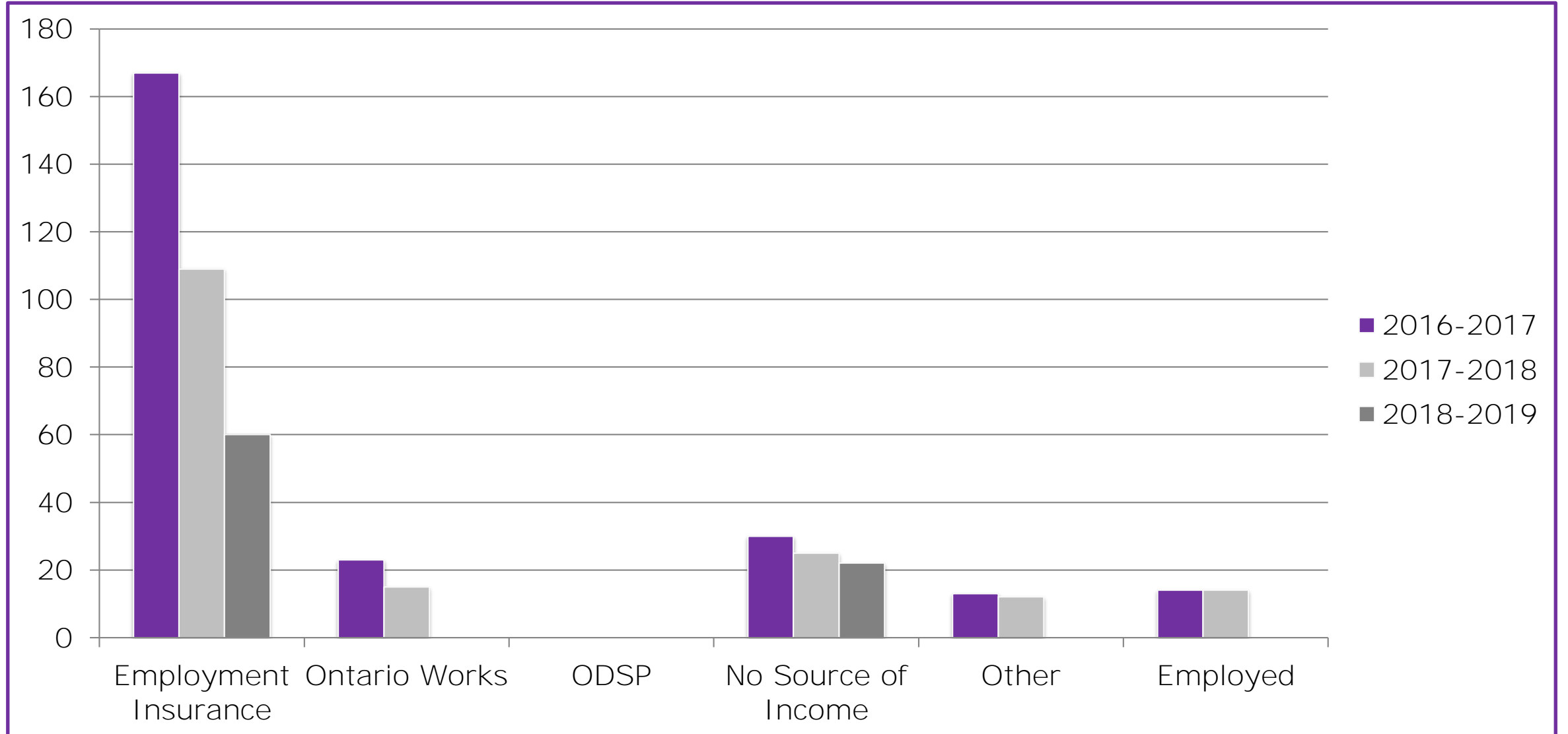

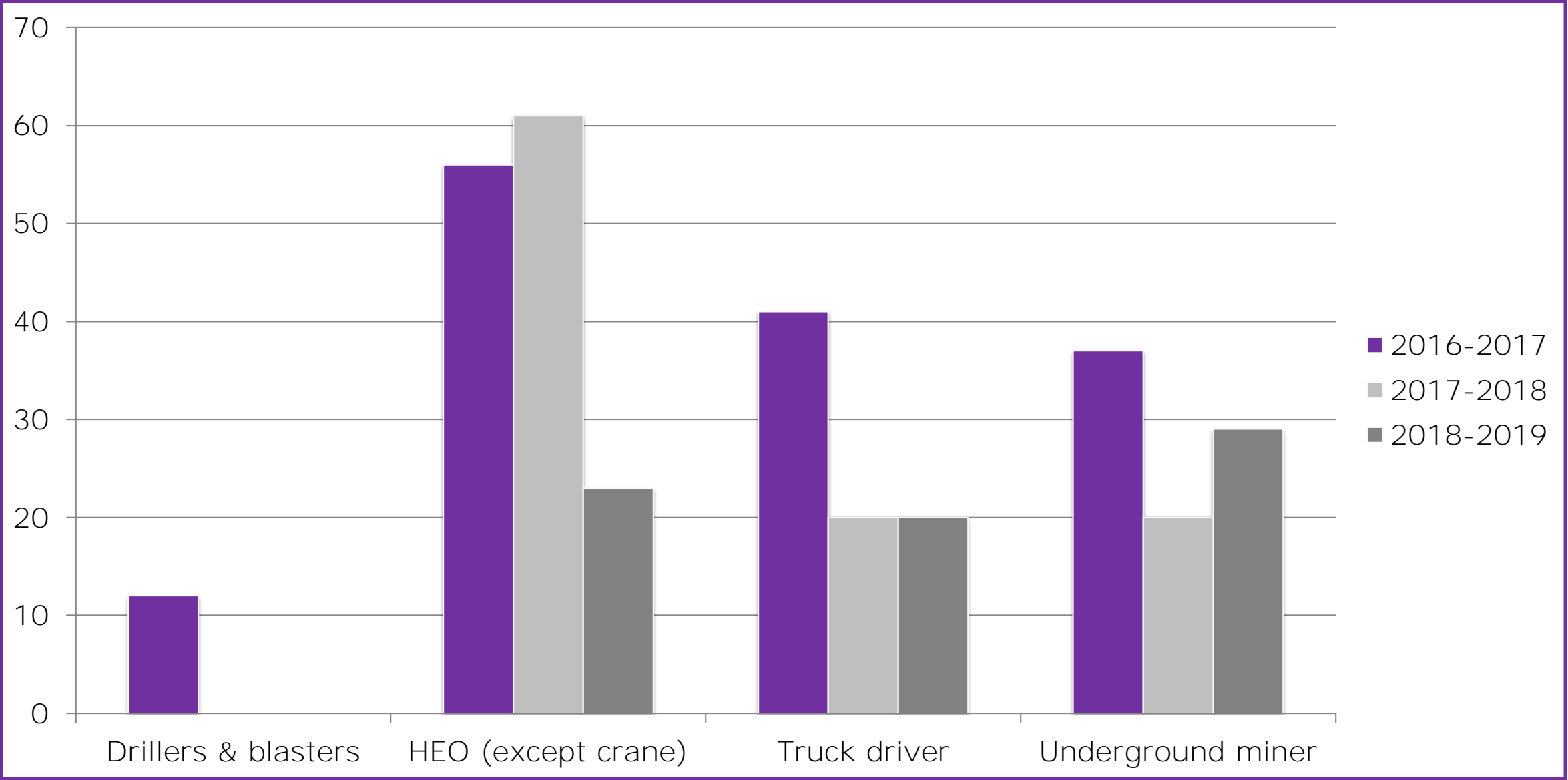

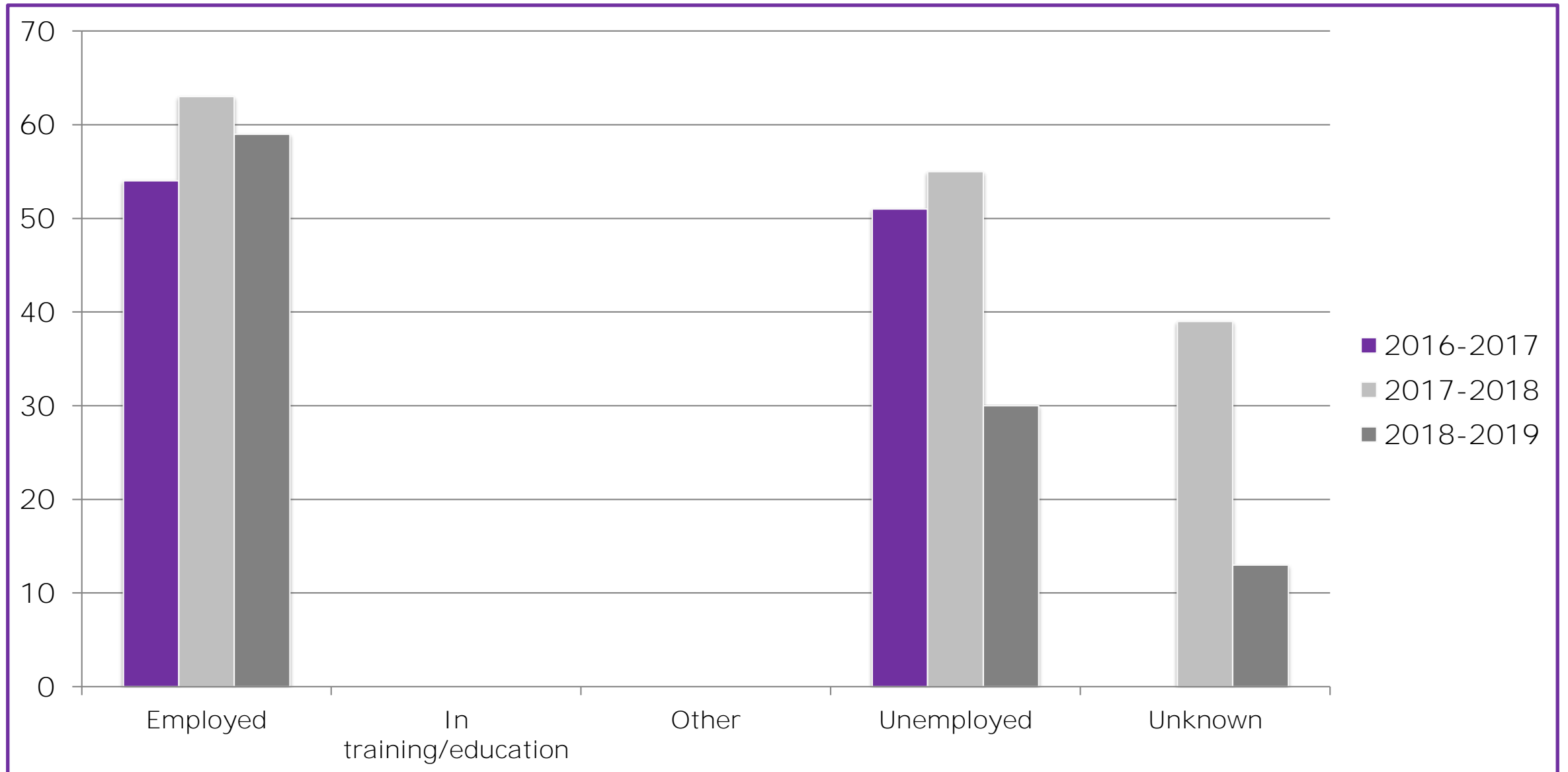

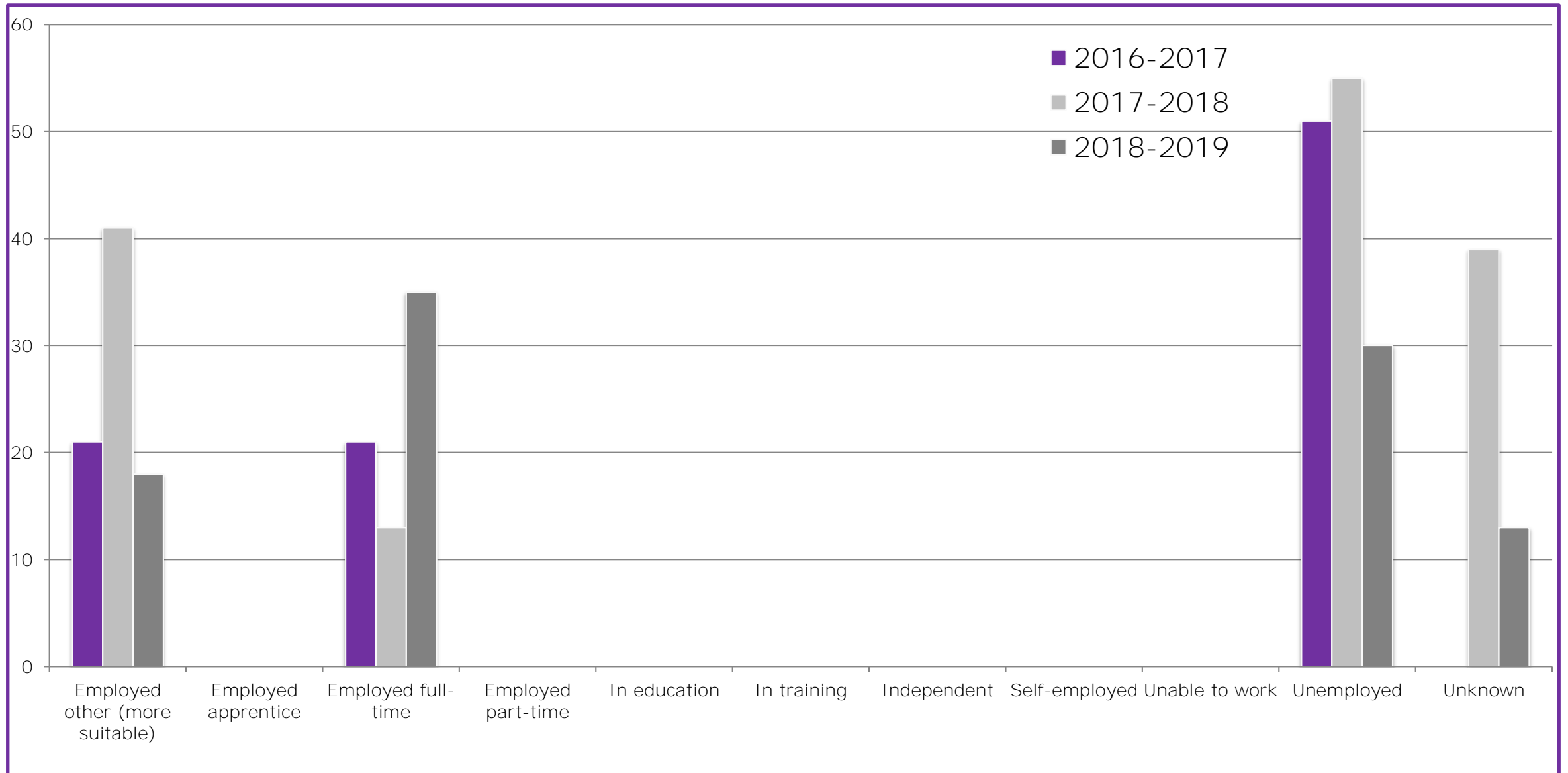

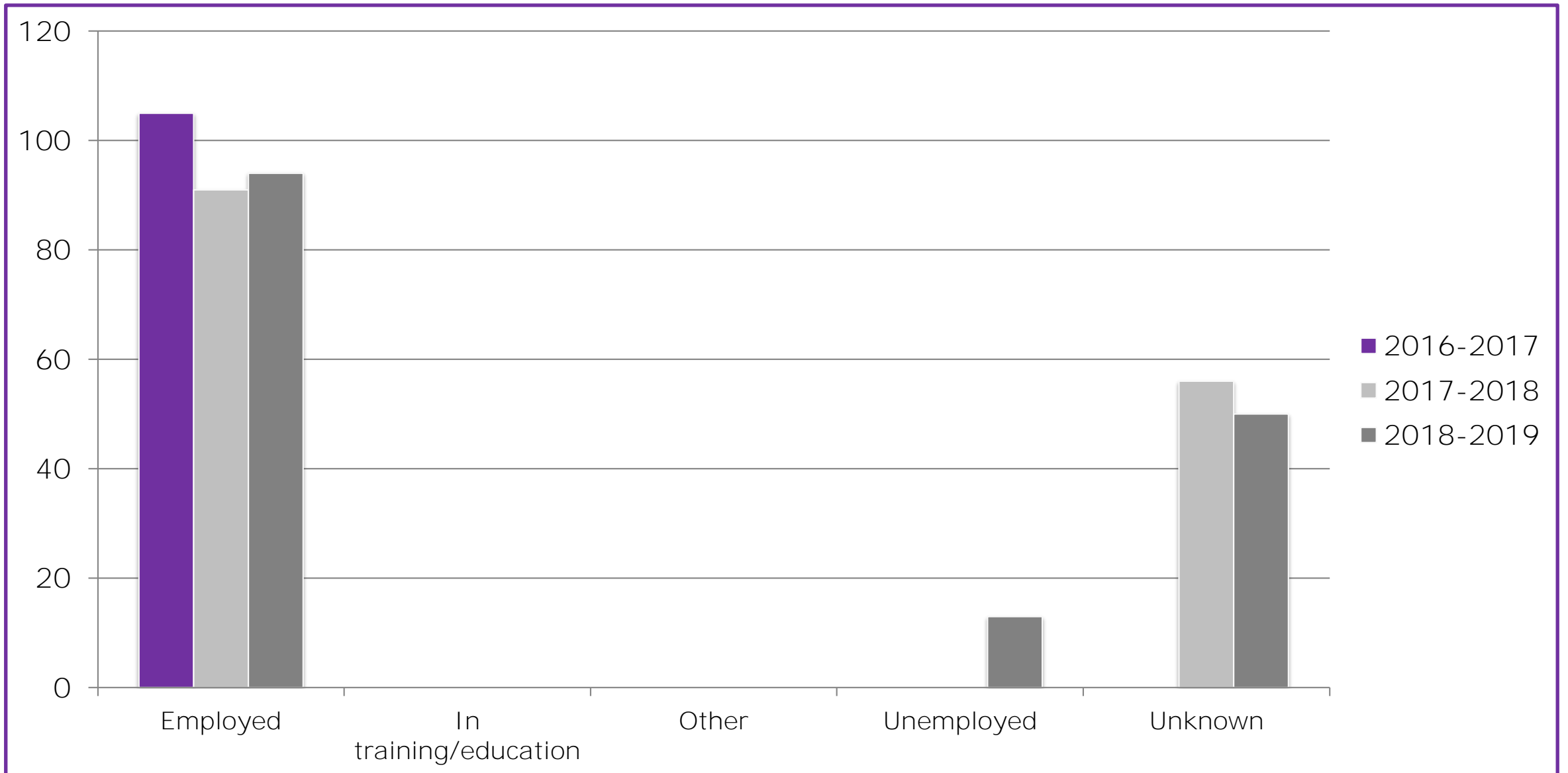

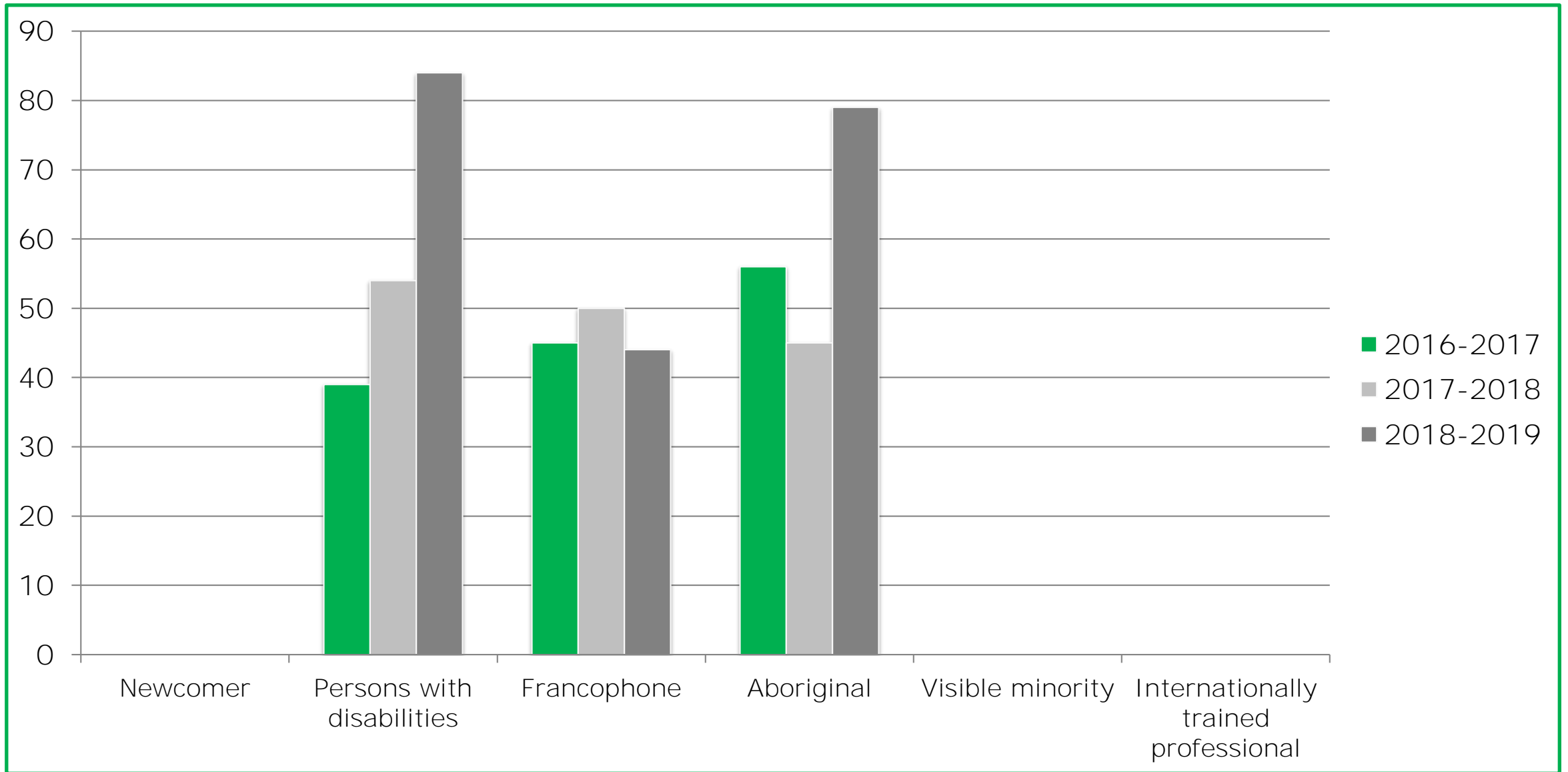

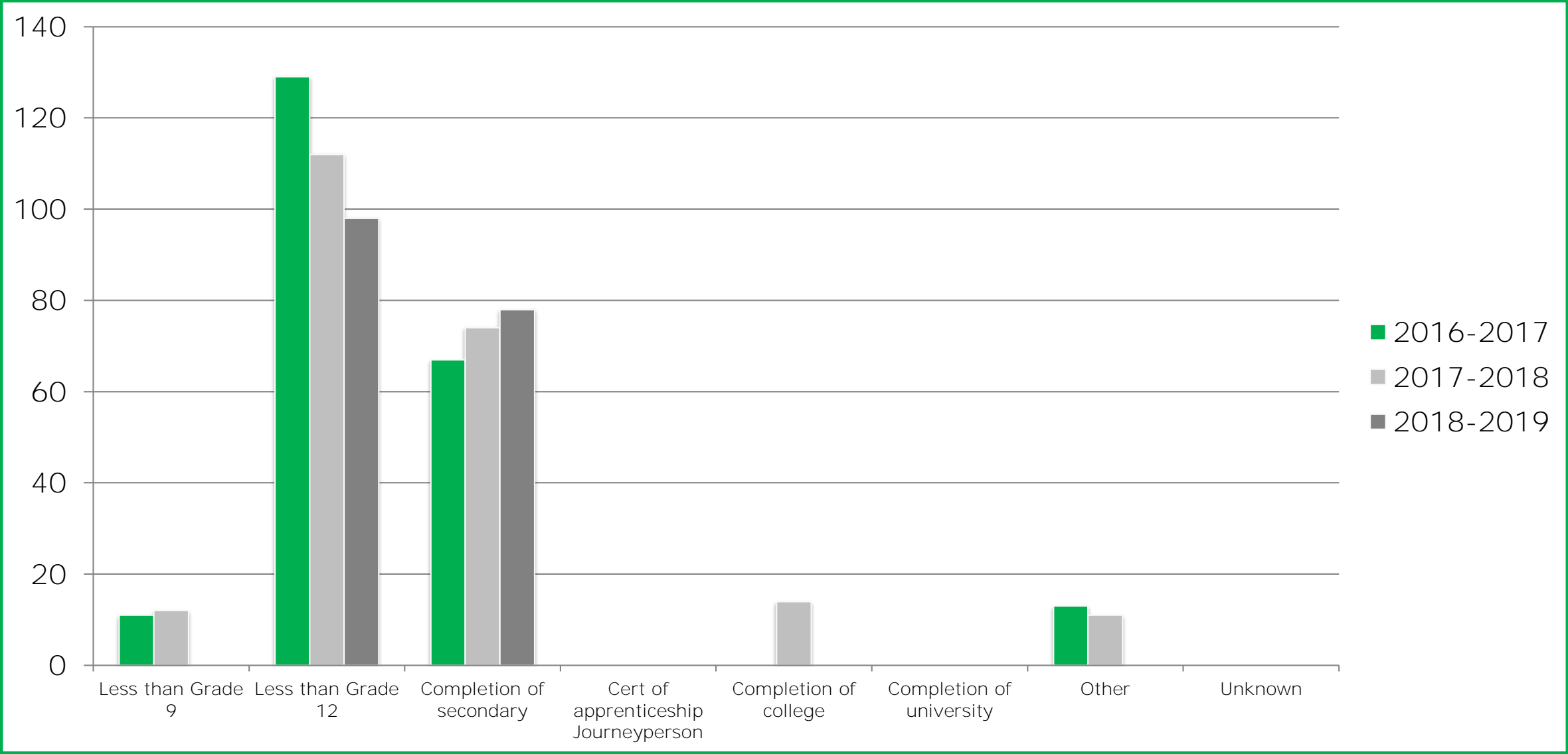

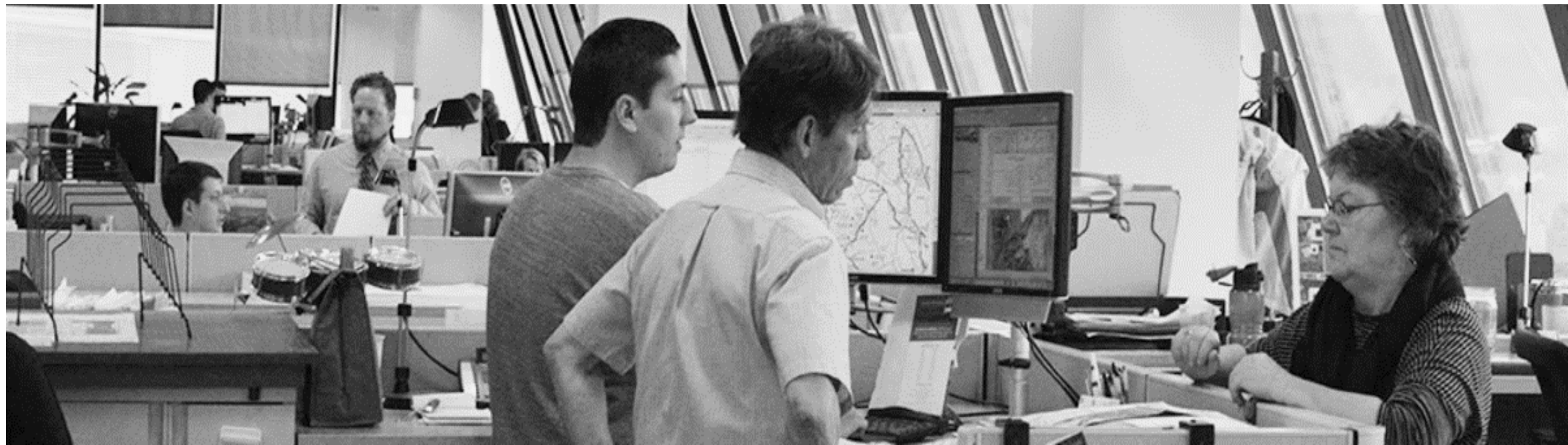

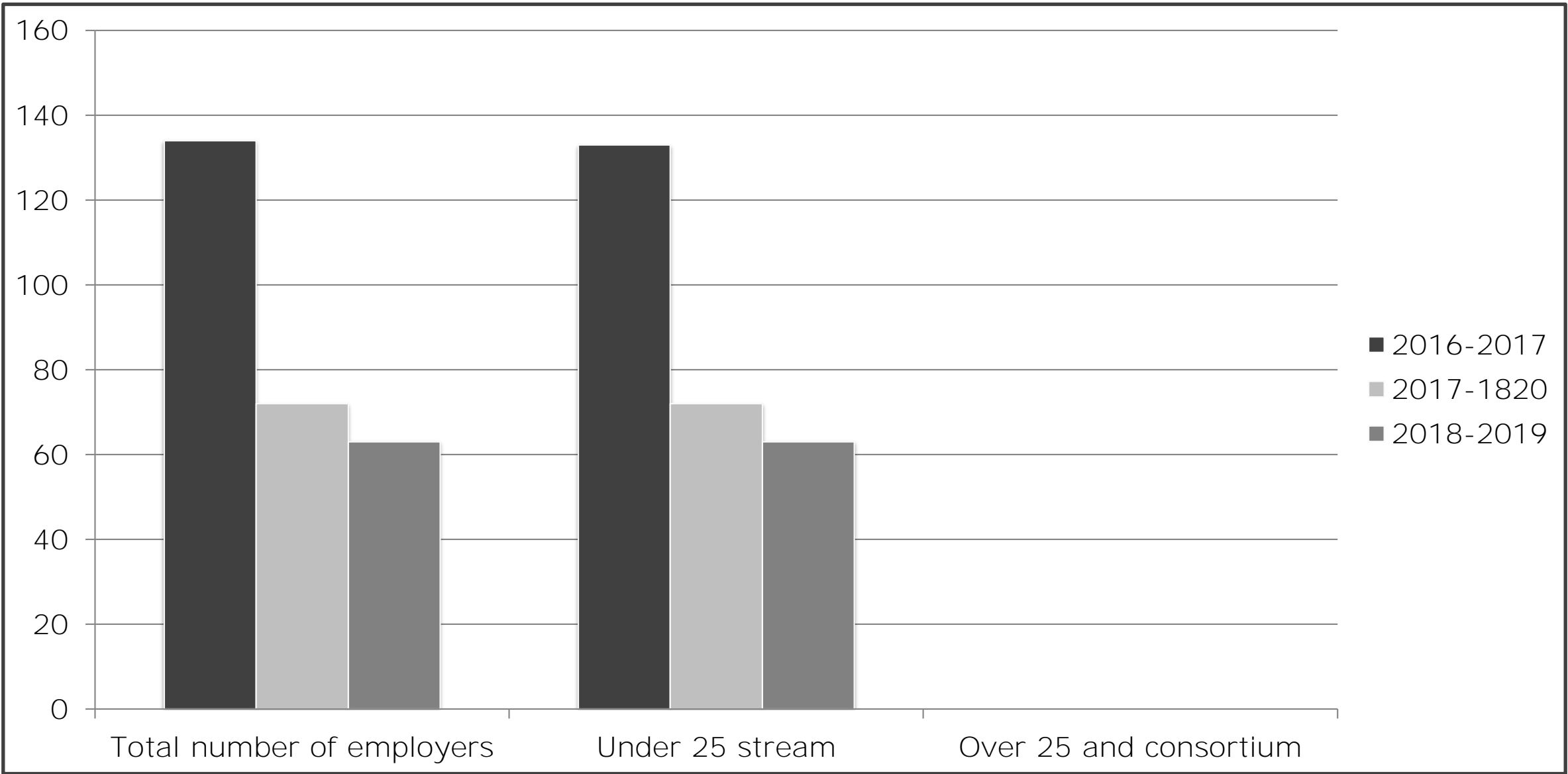

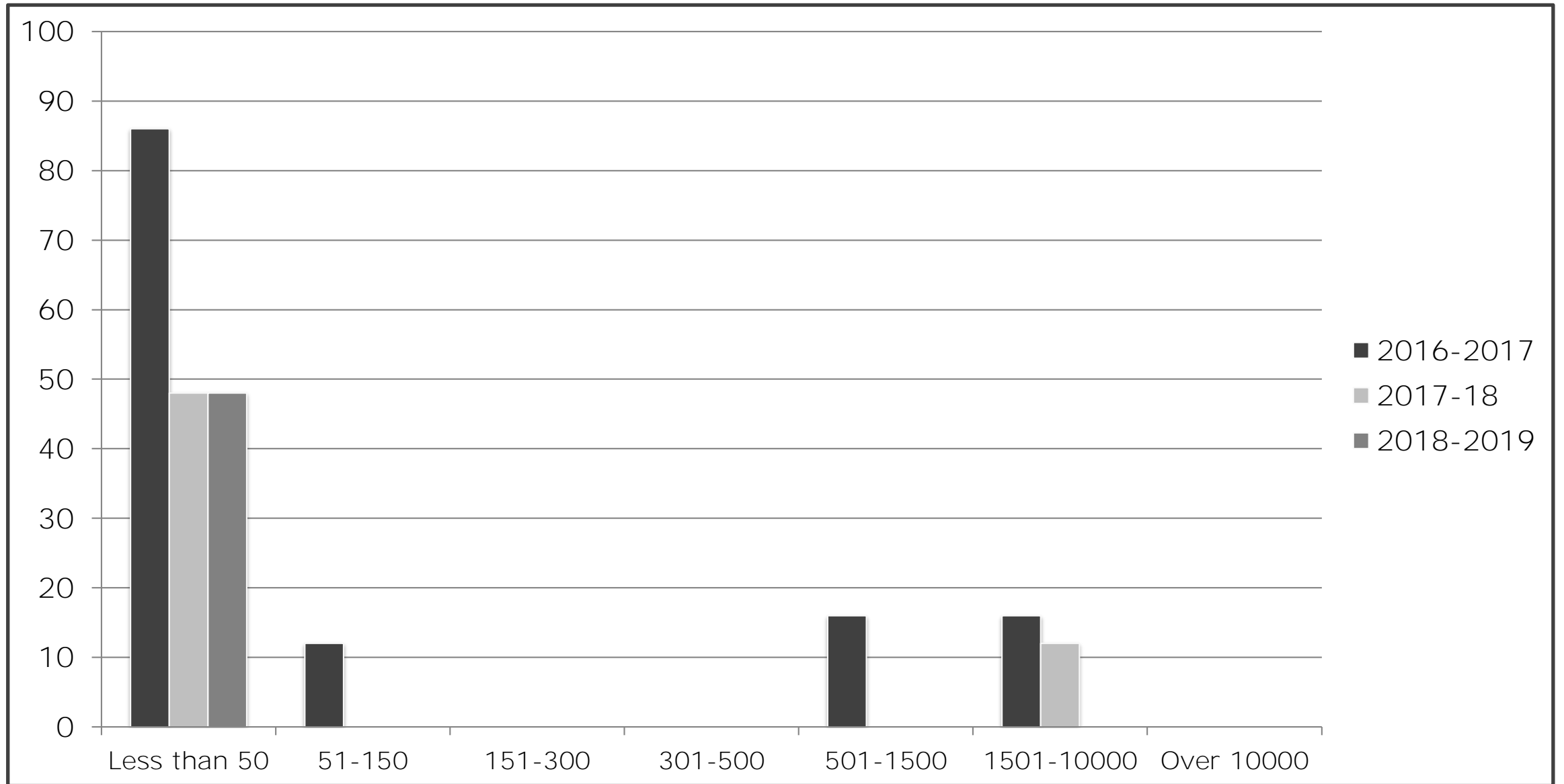

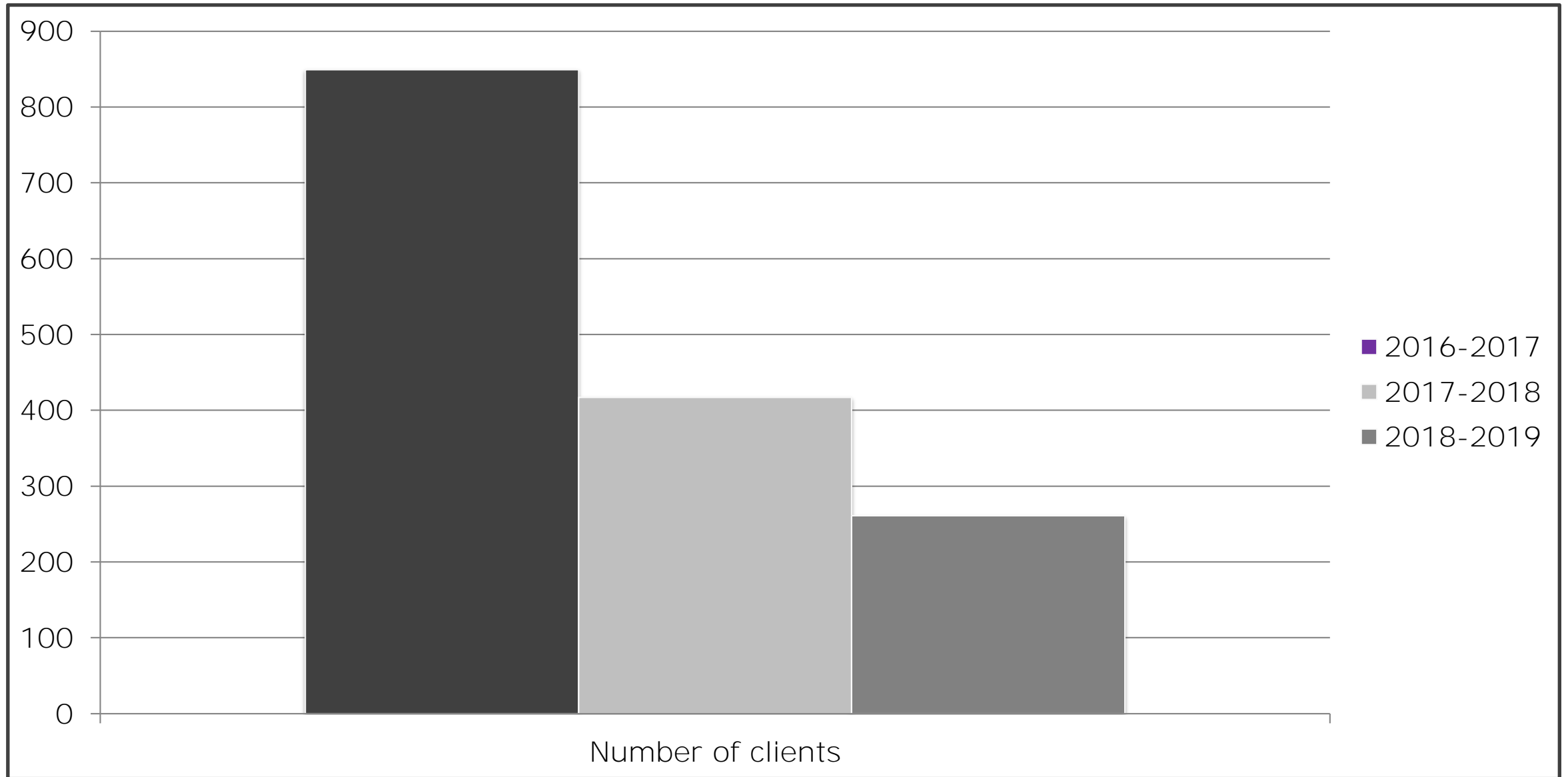

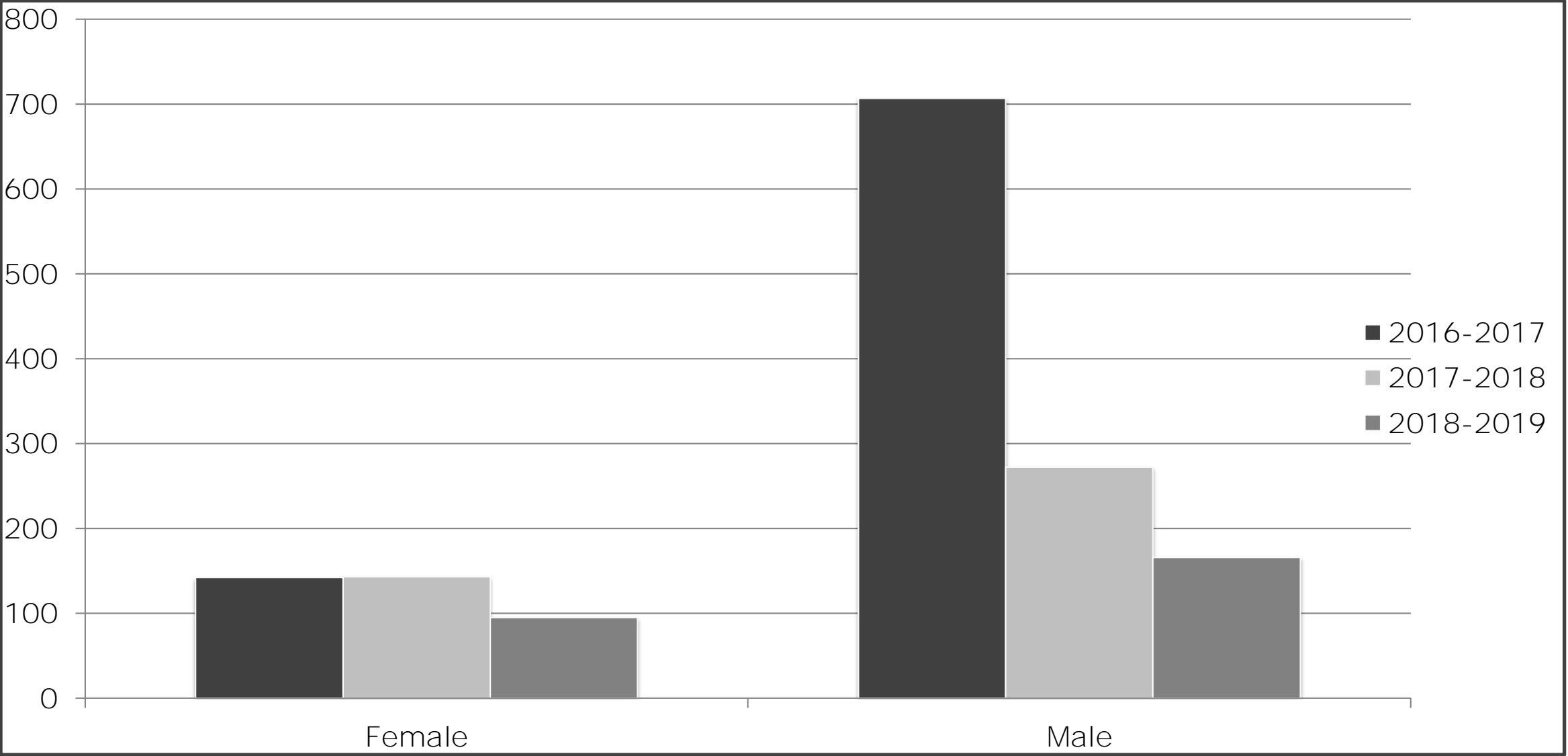

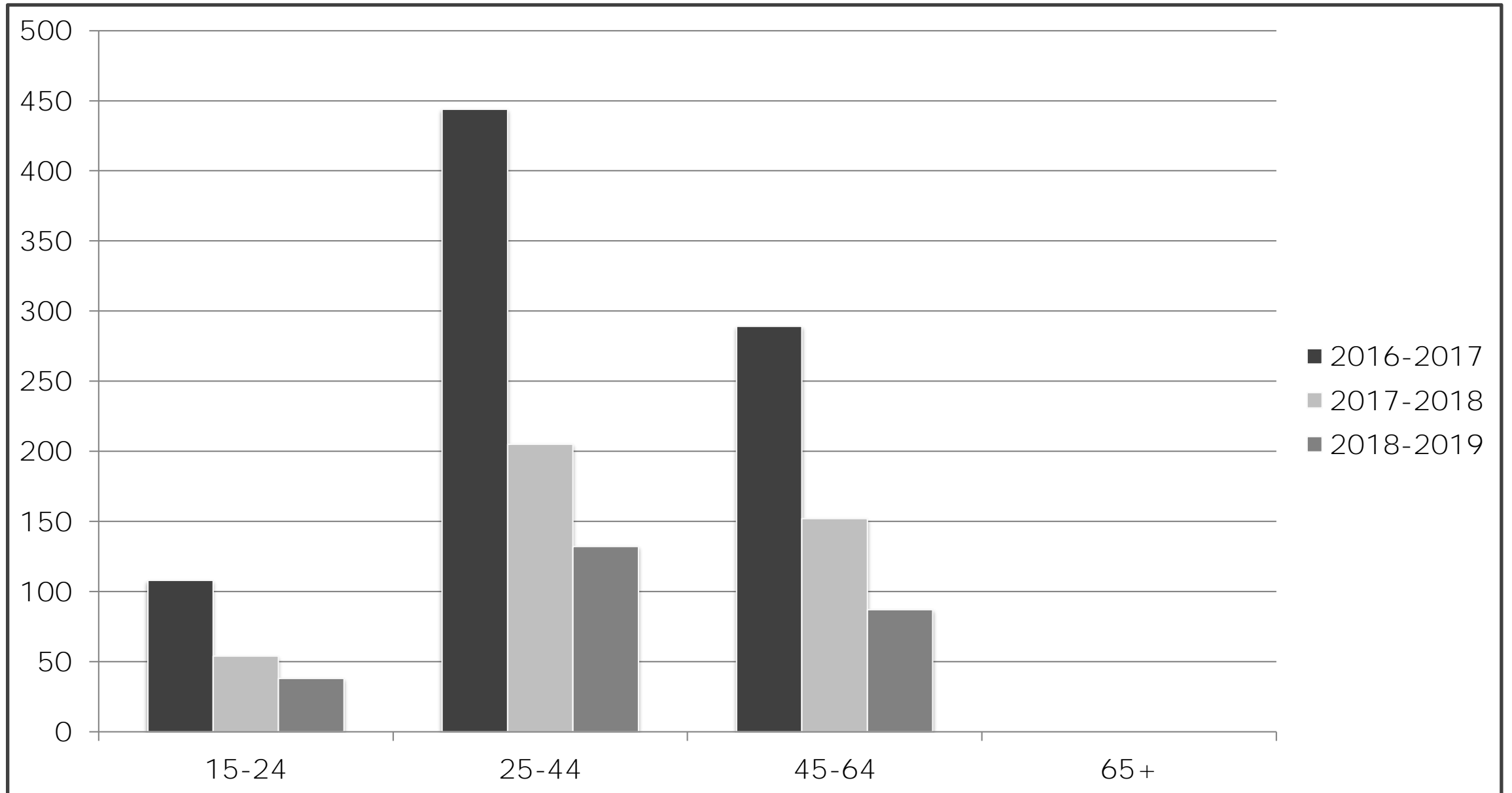

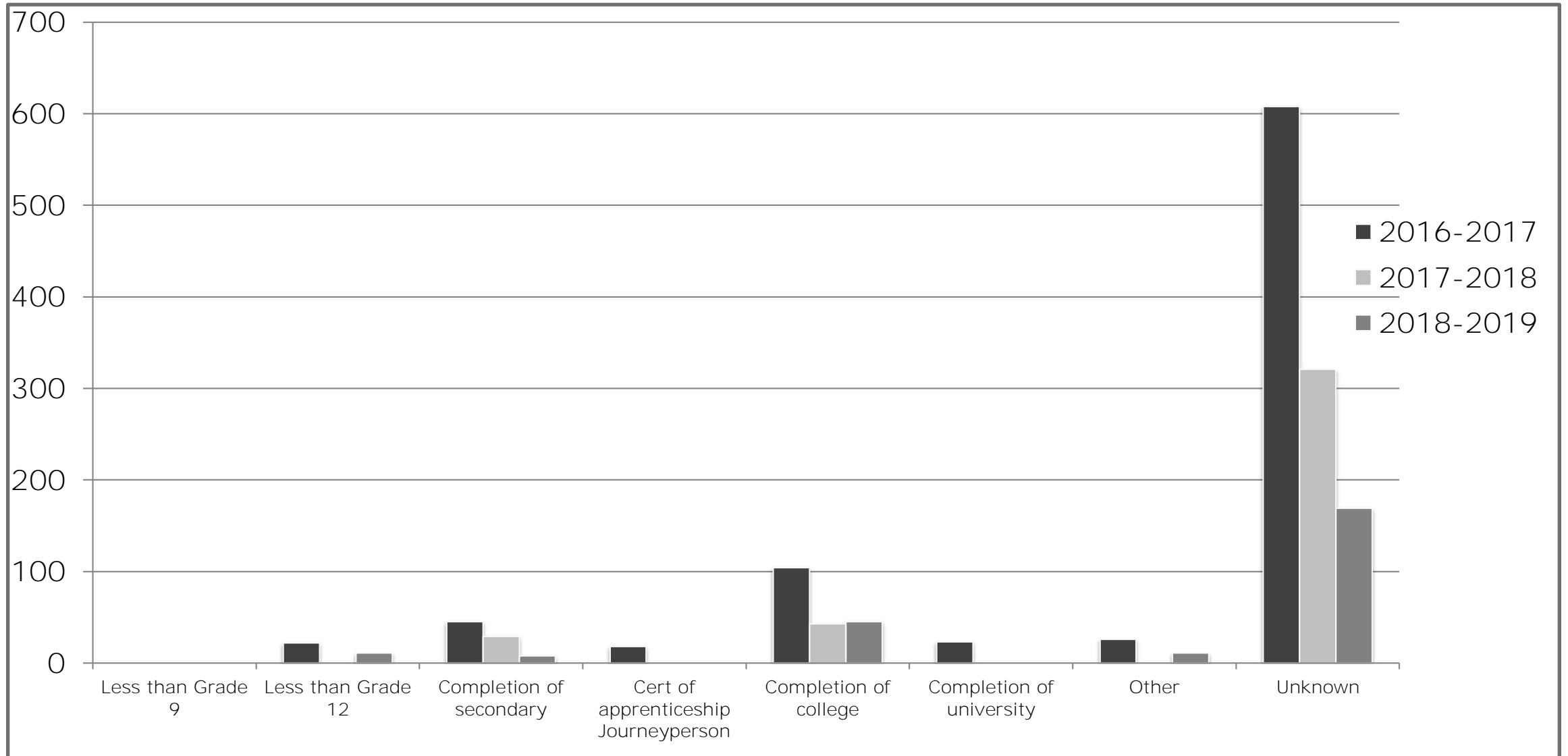

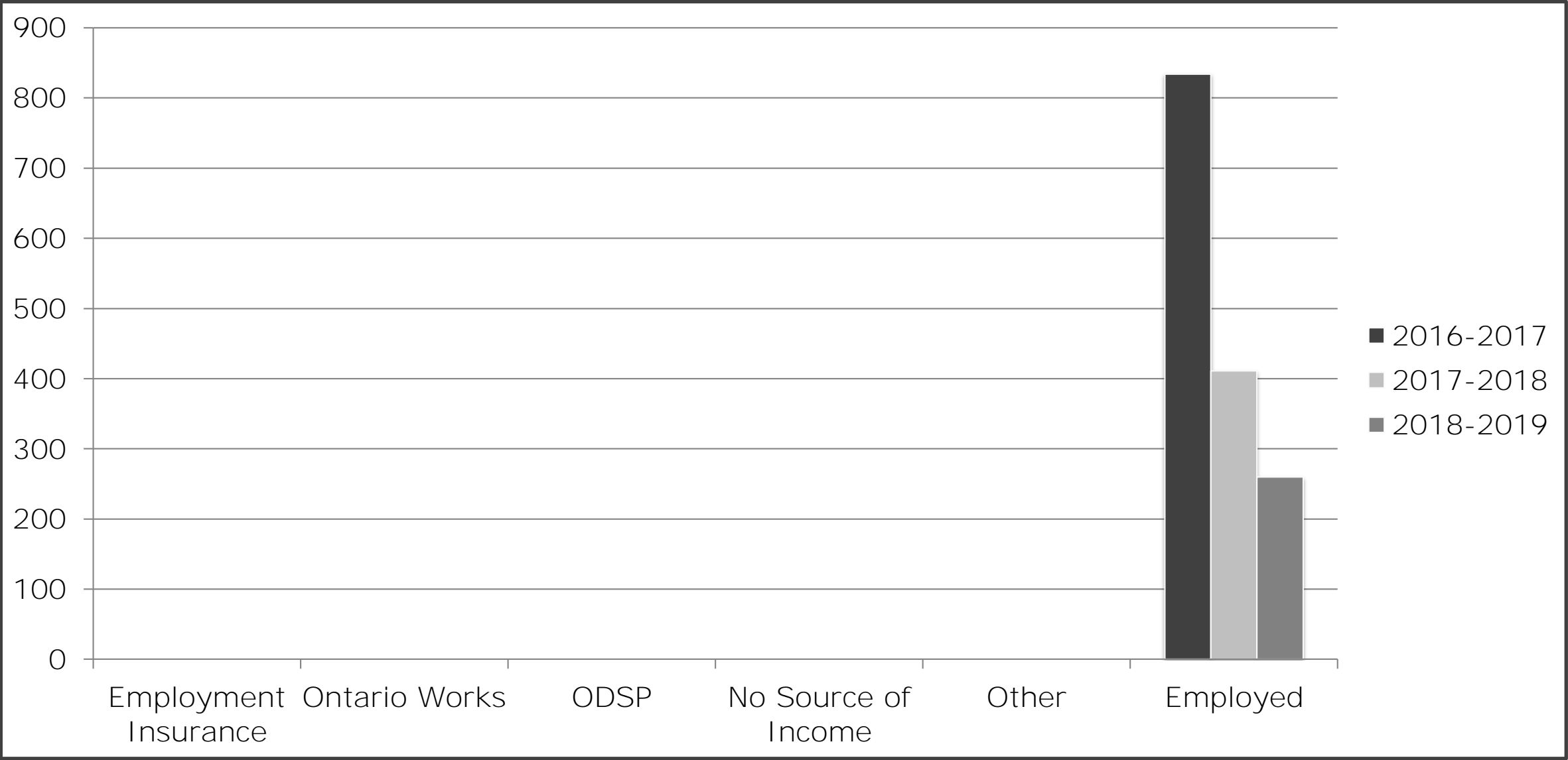

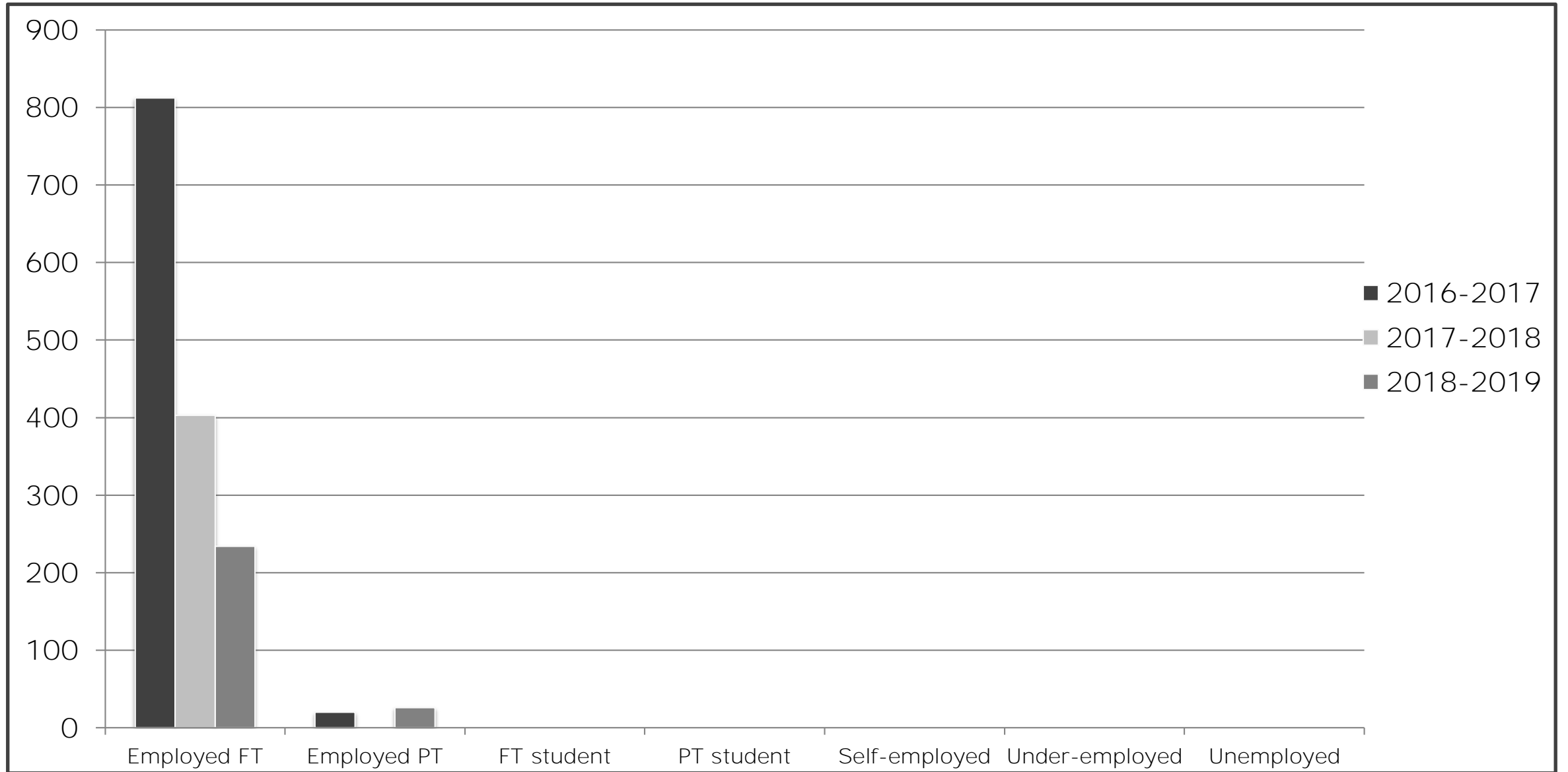

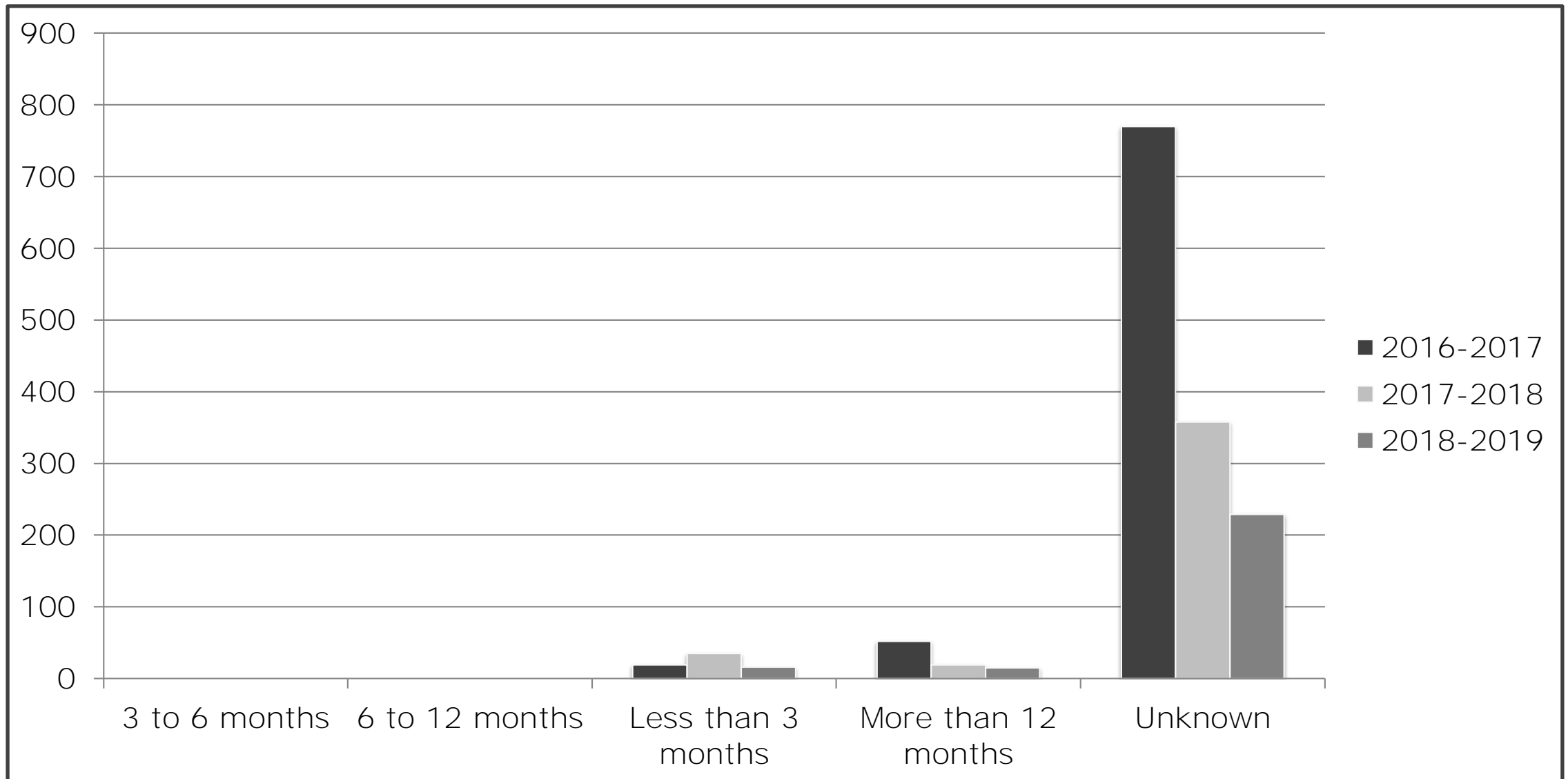

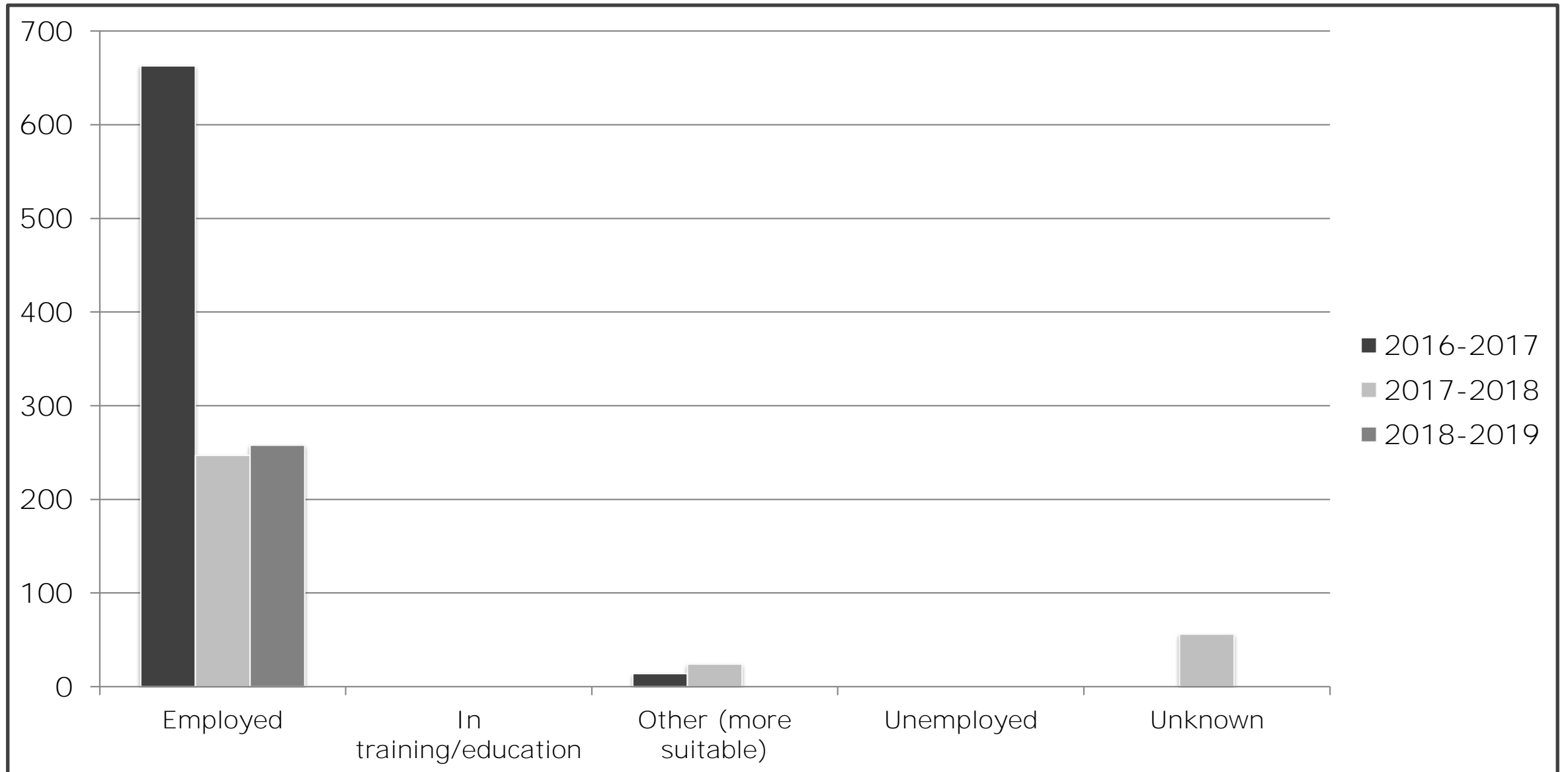

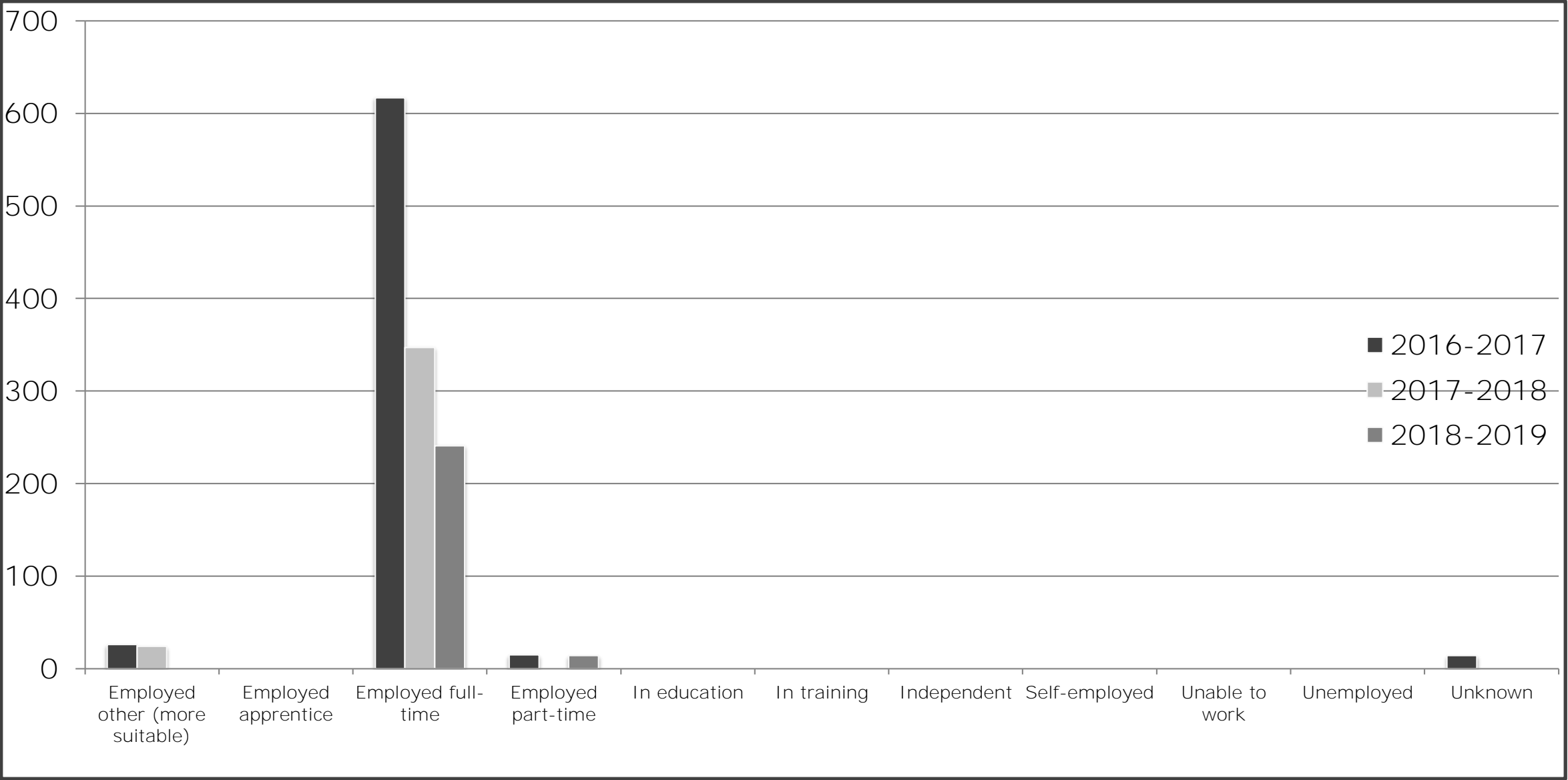

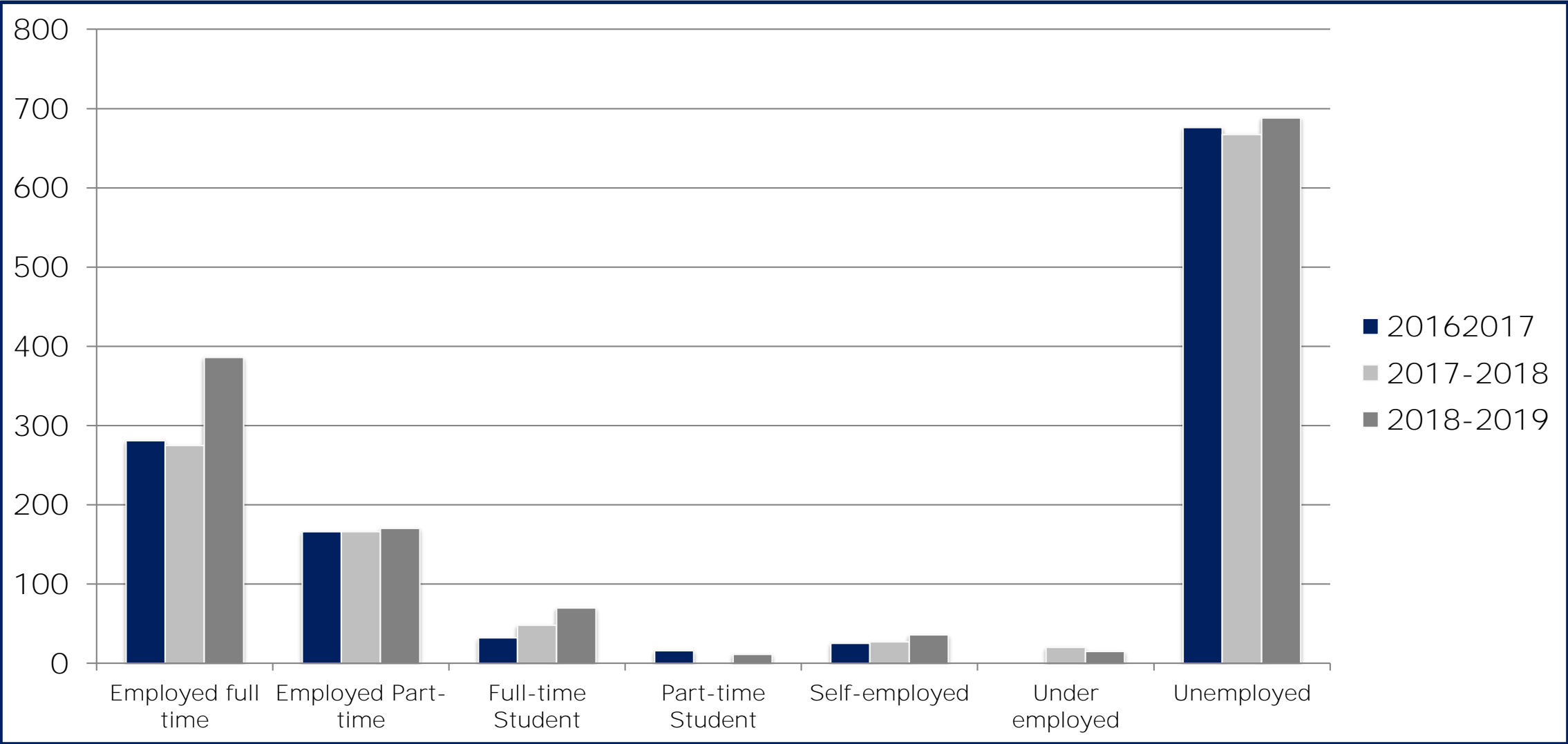

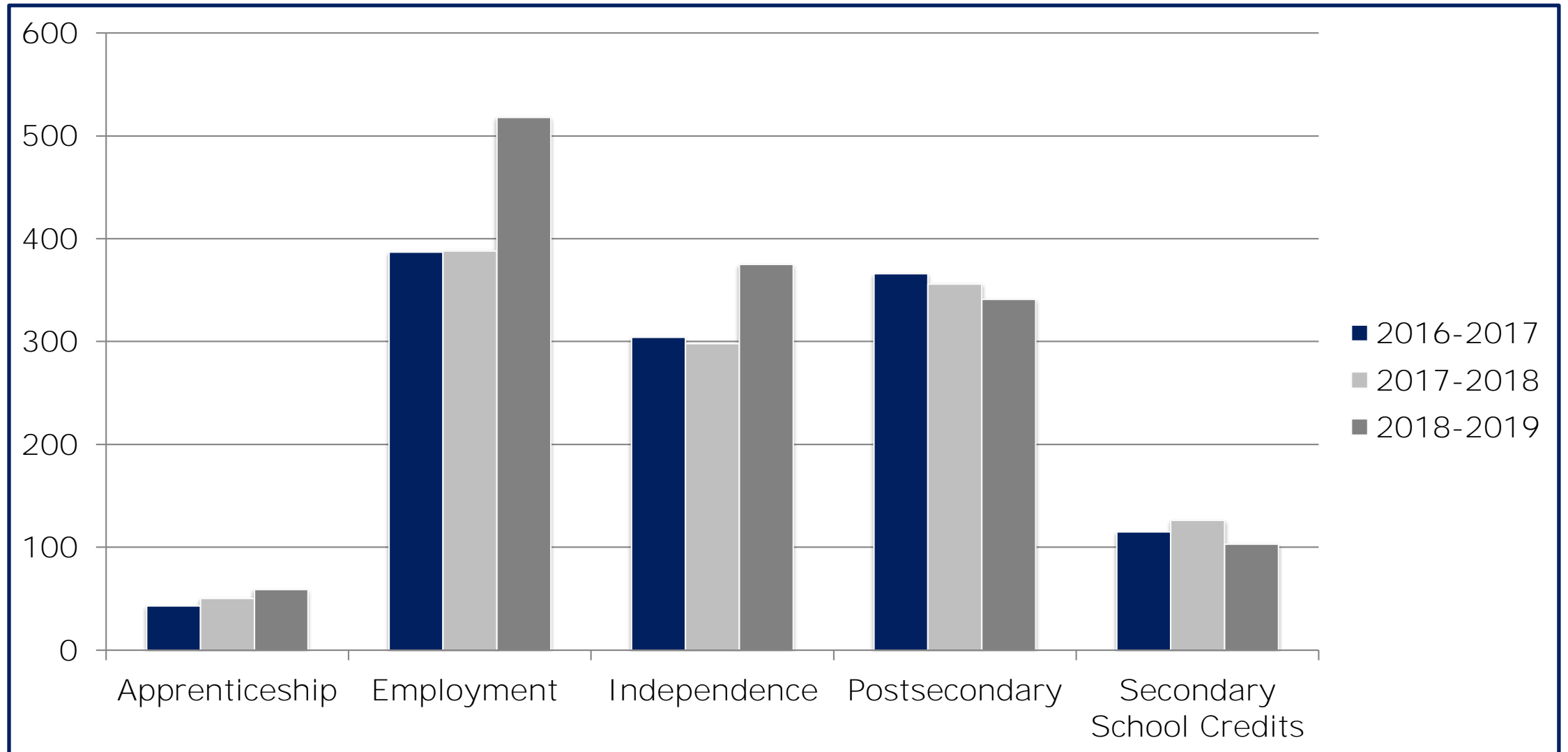

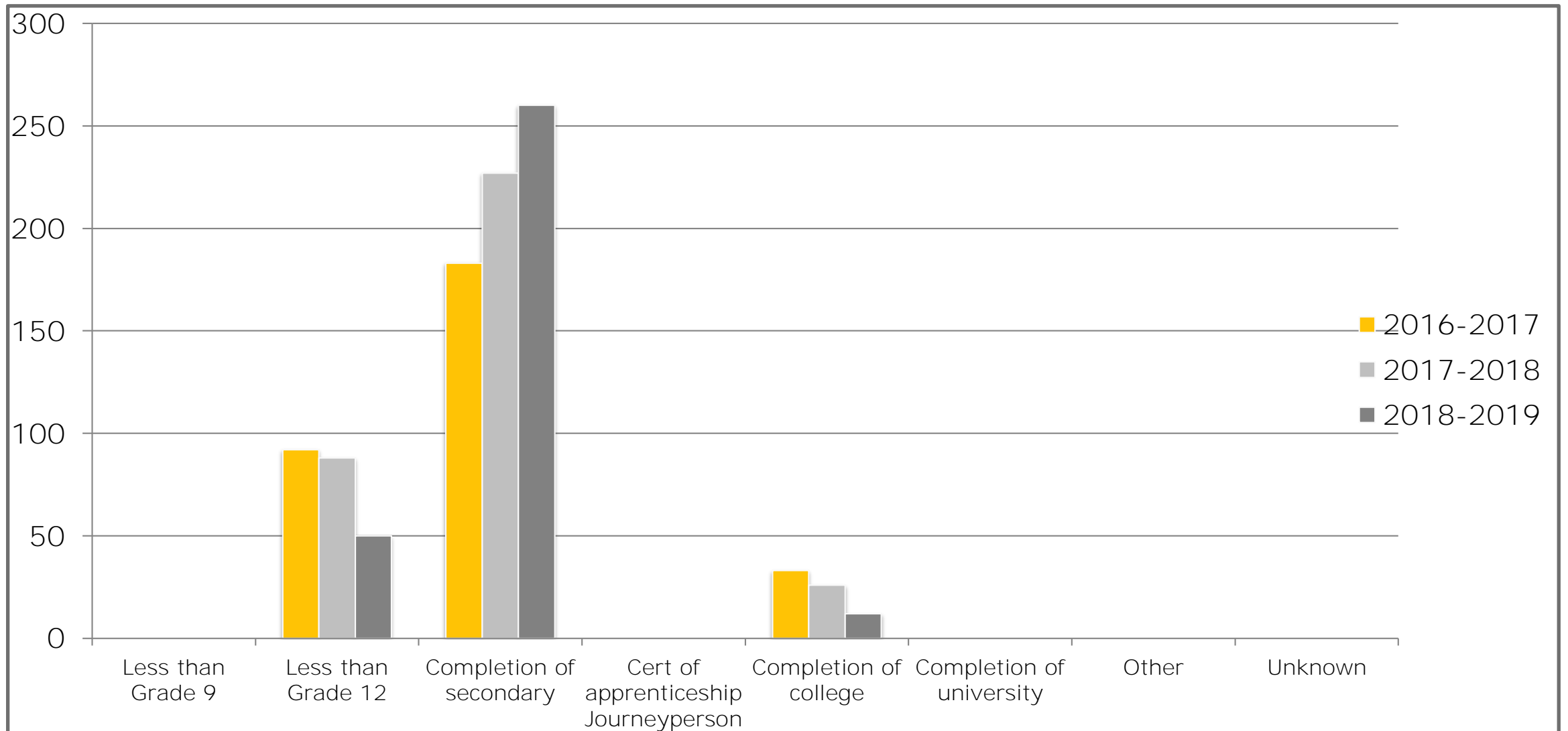
